### **Water Network Project**



### **Project Objective**

 Decrease water loss and improve efficiency of water delivery by rehabilitating and restructuring the network.

#### **Status**

 Water network construction conventional contracts will be released early next year.



# **Water Smart Homes Activity**



### **Project Objective**

 Improve the condition of home water systems and decrease costs that households, particularly poor households, in Zarqa Governorate incur to satisfy their subsistence water needs.



#### **Status**

- The RFP of the Water Smart Homes-Social and Outreach Services will be released in the first quarter of 2013.
- The RFP of the Water Smart Homes-Infrastructure Works will be released in 2014.

# MILLENNIUM CHALIENE ACCOUNT - JORDAN Partners in Development

### **Project Objective**

 Increase access to wastewater network, increase the volume of wastewater collected within Zarqa Governorate for treatment and reuse, and reduce the incidents of sewage overflow.

#### **Status**

- Groundbreaking ceremony was on 29 Nov 2012.
- Work commencing in different neighborhoods.

## MILLENNIUM HALLENGE ACCOUNT - JORDA

### **Project Objective**

Increase the capacity to treat wastewater from Amman and Zarqa Governorates as plant edges maximum capacity (267,000 cubic meters per day to 364,800 cubic meters per day)

#### **Status**

- GOJ signed agreement with the SPC for expanding of As-Samra WWTP under BOT for 25 years.
- Groundbreaking ceremony was 11 Oct 2012.
